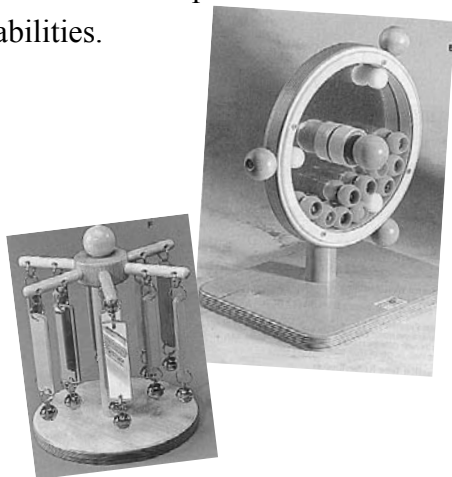

Since 1991 the Pre-school Learning Alliance, Leeds Sub-committee has managed a scheme to support the inclusion of children with special needs / disabilities in pre-schools. With the support of the Leeds SureStart Partnership (formerly the Early Years & Childcare Partnership) this has developed and been renamed Leeds Inclusion Support Scheme.

The aims of the scheme are:

- To promote the inclusion of children with special needs / disabilities within their local childcare or play provision.
- To enable a child with special needs / disabilities to benefit fully from that provision.
- To improve provision and practice
- To increase play and childcare opportunities for children with special needs and/or disabilities.

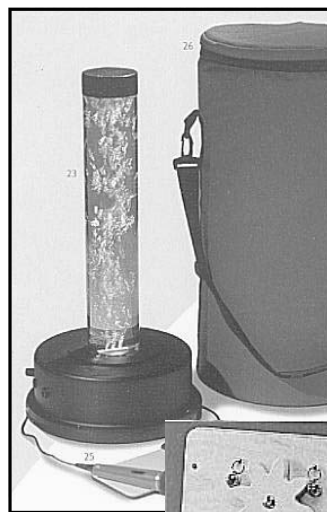


To further these aims we have created a Toy & Resource Library.

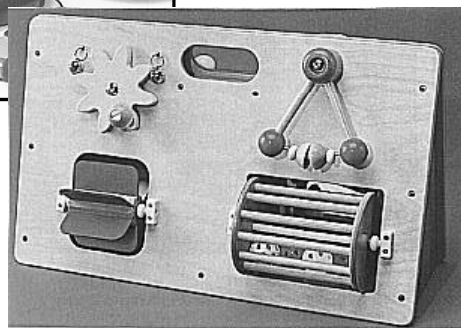
The Toy and Resource Library is on the 1st floor at East Leeds Children Centre, Seacroft, Leeds LS14 6SA

The library has an assortment of wooden toys by Edu-play and sensory toys from various suppliers. We



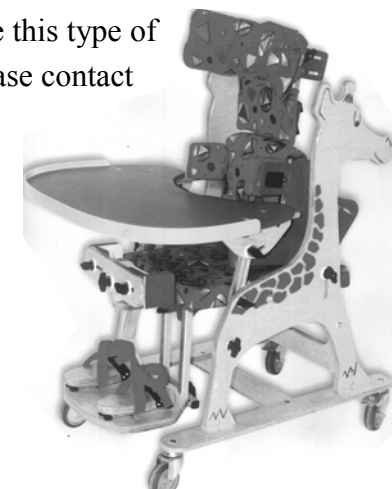
also have Jabadao resource bags, and more specialist resources that can be operated via a switch.

The scheme works in partnership with Leeds Equipment Store who are responsible for the cleaning, maintenance and storage of equipment.
